Now the friends of Jesus begin to speak. Listen! (Pause.) What're they saying? They're praising God (signal members: praise sound effect) in many different languages—languages they don't normally speak—for everything that God has done.

People gather outside the house, under the open windows. These people live in Jerusalem, but originally came from all different parts of the world.

They were amazed at what they heard coming from Jesus' friends. "How is it that these people inside the house are thanking God (signal members: continue praise sound effect)...and they're speaking in many languages, so we can all understand?"

"It's true: The Holy Spirit is here!" Jesus' friends shout. "And now we have the power to tell the whole world that God loves them!"
